GENERAL ADMIT AND FINANCIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please carefully read and review the following checklist in order to make your horse's admission into and discharge from our facility as seamless as possible.

1. Prior to arrival, please complete and return the Boarder Agreement and Horse Admission and Discharge Sheet. On the back of the Boarder Agreement, please provide all credit card information and signature.
2. Upon arrival, please submit any and all necessary Health Documents and Records.
 - o We require proof of Rabies and Rhino/Flu vaccinations within the last 4 months and a current negative Coggins test. We strongly recommend your horse be vaccinated for EWT and West Nile as well.
3. We recommend that you deworm and have your horse's feet done within 1-2 weeks prior to arrival.
4. We will provide owner-specified grain necessary for your horse's stay if possible. However, you are responsible for providing any additional supplements your horse may need.
5. We ask that you do not leave any lead ropes, wraps, blankets, or other extraneous items that are not necessary for use during your horse's stay.
6. Upon discharge, please note that all services must be paid in full.
